Playing magical games with Mickey and the gang will work up quite an appetite!
Serve up these Disney-inspired treats for your pint-sized partygoers.

Mickey Peanut Butter and Jelly Pinwheel Skewers

Ingredients

- 4 sandwich bread slices
- 4 tablespoons smooth peanut butter
- 4 tablespoons strawberry jelly
- 4 appetizer picks
- 4 assorted dimensional stickers

Directions

1. Decorate appetizer picks with dimensional stickers. Set aside.
2. With a rolling pin, flatten bread slices as much as you can. Cut off crusts.
3. Spread one tablespoon of peanut butter and one tablespoon of strawberry jelly on each slice.
4. Carefully roll each slice into a spiral. Slice into four pieces and insert appetizer pick to fasten the pinwheels closed.
5. If your appetizer picks are made out of wood, clip the sharp end with scissors. Serve and enjoy!

Copycat Disney Cinnamon Almonds

Everyone loves the Cinnamon Almonds available at Disney Parks. Now you can make this delicious treat for your playdate guests. From FamilyFoodFun.com

Ingredients

- 1/3 cup butter
- 2 egg whites
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1 cup sugar
- 4 teaspoons cinnamon
- 16 ounces whole almonds

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
2. Melt butter in an oven-safe bowl or cup.
3. Meanwhile, beat egg whites with salt until frothy.
4. Gradually add sugar and beat vigorously until the mixture is thickened and stiff peaks form.
5. Add cinnamon and beat until completely combined.

6. Fold in almonds until coated evenly.
7. Pour in butter and mix together.
8. Pour the mixture onto a foil-lined cookie sheet and spread to a single layer of nuts.
9. Bake for 40-50 minutes (or until the almonds are crisp), stirring every 10 minutes.
10. Serve warm or at room temperature.

Pixie Dust Popcorn

Ingredients

- Pop Secret Popcorn
- Vanilla candy melts
- Sprinkles

Directions

1. Pop the popcorn according to the instructions on the package.
2. Microwave the candy melts in a microwave-safe bowl, pausing every 20-30 seconds to stir. Repeat until melted.
3. Drizzle melted vanilla over the popcorn and stir in sprinkles.
4. Place in the refrigerator for 5-10 minutes to allow candy to harden prior to serving.

Mickey's Magic Wands

Ingredients

- 20 Pretzel Rods
- Vanilla candy melts
- Sprinkles

Directions

1. Microwave the candy melts in a microwave-safe bowl, pausing every 20-30 seconds to stir. Repeat until melted.
2. Dip the bottom half of each pretzel rod in the melted vanilla.
3. Immediately place on a plate or wax paper and add sprinkles.
4. Place in the refrigerator for 5-10 minutes to allow candy to harden prior to serving.
